

**Usage:** This round is used as an antitank and antipersonnel weapon. Due to its specially designed tripod-type mount (M79), the 106-mm rifle M40A1 or M40A1C can be fired from the ground or while mounted on the ½-ton truck or "mule."

Description: Ammunition for 106-mm rifles M40A1 and M40 A1C can be distinguished from other types of ammunition by the perforated cartridge case.

High-explosive cartridges have preengraved rotating bands; high-explosive antitank projectiles are fin-stabilized and, therefore have no rotating bands. The designation of the weapon is marked on the containers and on the base of the cartridge case of each round.
